

How to 'Control Garden Pests!'

Fighting pests without chemicals



- 1) Lay Horticultural fleece over crops susceptible to cabbage white caterpillars.
- 2) Sprinkle sharp sand or horticultural grit around susceptible plants.
- 3) Wrap copper impregnated band around pots.
- 4) Place a fine vertical mesh around carrots to prevent carrot fly.

Companion Planting

Top tip: Many insects detest strong scented plants such as marigolds or chives.

What else can I try?

- Slug pellets
- Pesticides
- Nematodes
- Traps
- Egg Shells
